EVENT 1 = DELIVERABLE D1.1: INTERCULTURAL FESTIVAL

The **INTERCULTURAL FESTIVAL** took place on the 6th of September 2025 in Comuna Bălăușeri (Romania), serving as a vibrant celebration of shared European heritage. While the initial proposal estimated 250 direct participants, the event successfully exceeded targets, gathering a total of 381 direct participants. This included 125 international participants from Tápiószentmárton (Hungary), Gerjen (Hungary), Fót (Hungary) and Zemianska Olča (Slovakia) alongside the host community.

Objectives:

- **Celebrate cultural diversity:** Showcase and appreciate the unique cultural traditions of participating municipalities.
- **Promote intercultural dialogue:** Facilitate meaningful interactions and exchanges between different cultural groups.
- **Strengthen community bonds:** Build connections and solidarity among citizens of the participating towns.
- **Educate on European heritage:** Raise awareness of the shared cultural and historical heritage of Romania, Hungary and Slovakia.

To achieve these goals and objectives, all preparatory and implementation tasks outlined in the project plan (Tasks 1.1 through 1.5) were fully respected and successfully executed.

- **Planning, preparation, and promotion:** The event was supported by comprehensive planning, coordination with local vendors, and a widespread promotional campaign utilizing eco-friendly practices such as digital flyers and social media.
- **Inclusive cultural performances:** The festival featured concerts, performances, a local producers' and artisans' fair, exhibitions, other different programmes and an intercultural mini conference. It aimed to highlight the cultural richness of the participating towns through music, local crafts and community spirit.
- **Cultural and historical excursions/visits:** To provide a practical experience of Europe's diverse heritage, participants engaged in guided site visits to significant landmarks, including the Medieval Citadel of Sighișoara and the Reformed Church in Bălăușeri.
